Tariff Concession Approvals, Withdrawals and Declines Notice (No. 35) 2016

I, Simon H. van Weeghel, Supervising Customs Officer, Revenue and Assurance, New Zealand Customs Service, acting pursuant to section 8 of the Tariff Act 1988 under delegated authority hereby:
